This is Mia's friend Elphaba in a sleepsuit made from an old Bruce T-shirt - make a sleepsuit in one of your extra odd hand torn for the mind rocker in your life!

If you don't want cuffs on the sleeves and legs, you can simply leave them and simply skip steps 6 and 7.

### Sleepsuit

**Recycled original: a T-shirt**  
 You will also need ribbed trim and cuffs from a sweatshirt, a sleeve plucker from a men's shirt, handkerchief, green wash.  
 Pattern pieces: leggings front and back, 1 legging waistband and leggings cuffs from the pattern book on pages 110-111; oversized top front and back (using the long above outline) from the pattern sheet on pages 118-119

- Trace off the pattern pieces for the leggings and oversized top onto pattern paper and cut out. Tape the pattern pieces together at the waist so they look like a sleepsuit. Pin the pieces on the T-shirt and cut out with a fine (100) piece allowance, cutting on the front and back at the same time.
- Now to make the flaps. Place the pattern paper on the cut-out oversized top pattern and draw round the one below. About 2.5cm (1 inch) from the neckline, mark a curved line that follows the neckline. From this line and at each end, draw a line up to the shoulder seam. Cut out, place it on the original T-shirt and trace off. Cut out two flaps, adding a 1cm (1/2 in) seam allowance.
- Place one flap on the oversized front, right sides together. Sew around the neckline only using stretch (or triple straight) stitch. Fold the facing to the wrong side of the sleepsuit and press. Secure the facing by topstitching along the neckline on the right side of the sleep-suit, then 1/4 in (1/2 cm) from the neckline using stretch (or triple straight) stitch. Repeat on the oversized back.
- Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make and attach the cuffs flaps.
- Place the sleepsuit front and back right sides together then sew the shoulder seams and side seams. Turn the sleepsuit right side out.

- If you want cuffs, add them now. Cut open the ribbed trim and cuffs from the sweatshirt, open out and press. Using the cuffs pattern, cut out four cuffs. Sew to the top and bottom for the cuffs of the sleeves - with a 1cm (1/2 in) seam allowance.
- Join the short ends of each cuff right sides together and sew right side out. Fold in half lengthwise and press. The right side of the fabric should face outwards. Make a cuff over the end of each leg and sleeve, right sides together and use edge matching. Sew the cuffs in place with stretch (or triple straight) stitch. Draw them down right side out.
- Attach five green studs around the chest, following the manufacturer's instructions. If the brand labels around the chest create, making sure they're evenly spaced, then fit the male button on the back, making sure they align with the female button. You could recycle a whole strip of green wash from an organgee sleepsuit cut from one, including about five (100) of surrounding fabric so that you can see how it fits.
- Cut a sleeve plucker from a men's shirt and sew it to the neckline as in the instructions for the men's shirt on page 64, to steps 6, 7 and 8.

This is a treasure trove of ideas and inspiration for embroiderers and lovers of Japanese culture alike.

Jane Nicholas is one of the world's leading embroiderers, specializing in Stumpwork. Her exquisite embroideries in Goldwork and Stumpwork are inspired by Japanese family crests, a subject that has fascinated her for many years. In this book, Jane has selected 12 designs and interpreted them in a variety of ways using combinations of goldwork and raised and surface stitching. Measuring just 4in (10cm) square, each is worked on an assortment of silk Japanese kimono fabrics, and is accompanied by detailed instructions, a stitch diagram, and the outline for the design.

A fascinating history of Japanese family crests is followed by a stitch directory and a comprehensive techniques section covering the essential methods of working Stumpwork and Goldwork illustrated throughout with sumptuous photography and informative diagrams

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DETACHED LEAVES

- 1 Mount a square of quilted muslin into a small hoop then trace the upper, lower and right detached leaf outlines (make sure the leaves are facing the correct way).
- 2 Cut a 12cm (4 7/8in) length of olive-coloured wire for each leaf. Using one strand of light green thread, couch, then secure the wire along the central vein line, starting with one end of the wire at the tip of the leaf, and keeping the remaining wire free to work the outside leaf edge.
- 3 Couch the remaining wire around the outside edge of the leaf. Using one strand of medium green thread, couch then buttonhole stitch the wire to the muslin, leaving a short tail of wire at the lower end of the leaf. Work a row of split stitch on either side of the wired central vein.

BACKGROUND FLOWER PETALS

Work the background petals as follows:

- 1 Using one strand of dark pink thread in a size 10-curved needle, work a row of long and short buttonhole stitch along the outer edge of each petal.
- 2 Using medium crimson thread, fill each petal with long and short stitches, angling all the stitches towards the base of each petal.



BACKGROUND BUD PETALS

- 1 Using one strand of medium crimson thread, work a row of long and short buttonhole stitch along the outer edge of each petal.
- 2 Fill each petal with long and short stitch using dark crimson thread.





# Small Birds May Fly High

22.5 x 26.5cm (ix x xdin)



This piece was designed during the first UK lockdowns of the 2020 covid pandemic. As a result of this time we were used to had been curtailed and we were limited to our previous hour outside each day. It felt so awful, so shocking and so claustrophobic at first. Then gradually the building pressure of nature began to emerge into our world. The skies were empty of planes, the roads were quiet, the air pollution eased, signs and sounds long forgotten began to creep back to our consciousness: silence, stillness, loneliness, serenity.

The term symbol is very important to me. It was always known as 'Smey Winter' as a little girl and the original artist of the Royal School of Needlework was 'Small Birds May Fly High!'. The motto spoke of the RSN's early mission to provide training to embroidery as a means for working women who had fallen on hard times, to train a respectable skill by which they could care for their own living.

### YOU WILL NEED:

- Stain free, with washing measuring minimum 30cm (12in) or maximum 30cm (12in)
- Starch or clamo to support the base fabric
- 15cm (6in) diameter embroidery hoop
- 15cm (6in) embroidery hoop with deep edge for stand
- Flat iron free iron pen
- Curved-edge scissors
- Label typeface or stamps
- Stents
- Fine oil
- Paper napkin
- Leather sticky tape
- Lightbox, or equivalent
- Tray matting
- Needle
- Fabric scissors
- Large pinners
- Pair of tweezers

### FABRICS

- 30 x 30cm (ix x xdin) linen fabric, or a cotton linen fabric with thread count of between 50 and 55 threads per inch.
- Note:** If you opt for coarse fabric, a different weight of thread should be used - this will be stated in brackets following the thread recommendation for the fine fabric - **LA 60/12**
- These further pieces of the same linen, each measuring 20 x 30cm (ix x xdin)**
- King of the mountain - green silk, 30 x 30cm (ix x xdin)
- White, Breyer woven silk organza 20 x 25cm (ix x xdin)
- Piece of gingham fabric, 6 x 10cm (ix x xdin)

### THREADS

- The following threads included in brackets show the notation used for each thread throughout the instructions.
- Two shades of stranded cotton in bright blue (the original design is worked using DMC 8520/3). Use a single strand of 3.0mm (1/8in) length, unless otherwise stated. **ST**

- One reel each of the following 100% cotton low stretch (Dow Finest to brandings)
  - Size 10/2 **LA 60**
  - Size 10/2 **LA 60**
  - Size 10/2 **LA 60**
  - Size 10/2 **LA 60**
- Those used in the design are 70 ply DMC6 produced by Domanova. Use as 30cm (6in) lengths unless otherwise stated.
- One tube of DMC Carline Plus a Brother or light white 50/20 used in half-inch lengths of approximately 60cm (2ft 0in)
- One reel of pale blue or green polyester locking thread **LOCK** (one reel of) polyester locking thread **LOCK**
- At least 30cm (12in) of no. 50 optech cotton in light blue

### NEEDLES


- Needle no. 10 and no. 12
- Tweezer no. 20
- Chenille no. 20 and 24

### OTHER MATERIALS AND TOOLS

- Iron sheet of cottoned black or steel plate, cut as in the sketch at least 13 x 26cm (ix x xdin)
- Five 6mm round beads in translucent or white
- 7 Framing for an equivalent design (designs on hand with an approximate diameter of 3cm and a large hole)

### A note on Tulle & Tricot

Tulle will be used only in some areas but also used to ease for speed and effectiveness of packing. When tulle is used, the thread will be passed simply through the needle, inserted over and the two ends tied together. The needle is therefore trapped in the centre of the loop of thread.




These samples are worked on an alternative thread with 12 threads per inch (Dow Finest), using floss of choice, number 12.

### FREELY WORKED STAR EYELETS

Freely worked eyelets create a deep, three-dimensional effect on the ground fabric. They are not curved and are therefore relatively quick and easy to make. They can be worked in a variety of sizes or made of thread, and these variations can create a pleasing effect in terms of scale, weight and density. They are therefore one of the most versatile and widely used thread stitches.

### STARTING THE THREAD AND WORKING THE FIRST EYELET

- 1 Begin the thread with a knot on the surface of the work. Carry the thread, approximately 3cm (1 1/4in), behind the area you are about to work.
- 2 Choose a centre point for the eyelet and work the first stitches into the design, guided by making the needle rise into the centre point.
- 3 Work stitches of varying lengths around the eyelet, each deepening down into the centre hole.




**Tips**  
You can work either clockwise or anti-clockwise around an eyelet.  
You may wish to use a stent to open the eyelet hole further.

**Tips**  
Maintaining an even tension is essential for working effective pulled thread work. Stitches must be pulled firmly and evenly to achieve a strong base for effect. Practice (on a scrap piece) until you understand the stitch well and achieve a rhythm of work, before applying to a design. Since this will ensure an even finish. However, varying tension can also be an effective means of creating shading in some work.

Try to ensure you have sufficient thread to complete a full row of stitch. Start too difficult with many stitches to get sufficient in the middle of a row. If a thread breaks in the middle, unpick back to the edge of the shape and finish the thread.

### WORKING THE SECOND EYELET

- 1 Once the first eyelet is complete, ensure that the last stitch pulls away from the hole as you leave to the next eyelet. Otherwise, you may not see the working thread weaving across the hole, thus obscuring it.
- 2 Work a stitch over one thread of the ground fabric, show by the green circle in the diagram. This stitch pulls the thread away from the eyelet hole and not diagonally into the hole. You can then leave space for the next eyelet without obscuring the hole in any way. It is not always necessary to work a locking stitch when moving to the next eyelet. This will depend on where you work the next eyelet. This is to ensure another eyelet is made between eyelets in any decision however.
- 3 As you begin the next eyelet over the stitch in diagonal, ensure that the first stitch does not touch the thread between the first eyelet. This will ensure a good tension on the new eyelet, and the full effect of your effectivity.



### FABRIC EYELETS

Blank circle points of random shape, each looking like the shape of the existing ones. Alternatively you may prefer to leave some ground fabric showing between eyelets.

The green circles in the diagram will show the path travelled between eyelets on the reverse of the work.

The paper circles are the locking stitches (worked over a single thread) which are used to secure an eyelet before moving on to the next.



### Beginning to work the fifth eyelet

The working thread must be inserted in the hole to the fourth eyelet. This gives a good tension on the hole and allows it to open as the hole.

### FINISHING THE THREAD

To finish the working thread, turn to the reverse of the work and slide the thread through the back of a hole of the eyelet stitches.




### COUNTED HONEYCOMB STITCH

Honeycomb stitch is worked in horizontal rows across the fabric and produces a beautiful lattice-like effect, reminiscent of hexagonal coils of honeycomb, punctuated by small holes.

Public thread stitches may be worked within a design area with a solid outline. If the design has a solid border, the needle can be worked in the normal fashion using the 'X'1' Other stitch, such as the first needle shown previously, can be secured by working the embroidery over the casting on thread to secure. However, some skilled needleworkers have created thread on the reverse for which this technique is unsuitable.

If the work is being counted under using the pulled thread stitch, with no raffia to be worked, and the stitch has material reverse coverage, the following method can be used, hiding the casting on process beneath the embroidery stitch.



**APPROXIMATE TIME**

Under one hour  
**KNOTS USED**

**MATERIALS AND TOOLS**

- 2m (6ft 7in) of 6mm (1/4in) 3-ply twist macramé rope
- 1 large statement bead
- (Alternatively you can use 3 large wooden beads)
- 30cm (12in) of 1mm (1/16in) leather string
- **Leather string**
- 1 pair of cord ends with crimp and scissor, ferns (1/4in) hole
- Strong glue or glue gun
- Scissors

**PREPARATION**

- Cut 2 x 1m (3ft 3in) twist macramé rope
- 3 x 30cm (12in) leather string

## Statement bead

This is a truly unique necklace yet is so simple to make. The trick is to use a statement bead and luxurious string to make it a real show-stopper.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Pass the strings through the statement bead and place it in the middle.
2. Separate the two macramé ropes and use the leather string to create a gathering knot on each side using the leather string, making it about 2cm (3/4in) long.
3. Gather the ends of the string and fold them next to each other going the opposite way.
4. Tie a gathering knot around the ends with the leather string.
5. Trim the string ends.

**IF YOU RUN OUT OF STRING.**



It happens to everyone and there are a few ways you can add additional strings to finish your piece. Before you add the new string, make sure you leave a long tail at the end of the old string. Once your piece is complete, you will have to reattach the tail at the back of your macramé and cut the ends. You can use a large-eyed tapestry needle to do that.

**ADDING A STRING WITH A SQUARE KNOT**

- 1 Place the two working strings up behind the cover and end of the way. These are the strings you are replacing.
- 2 Place the new folded string behind the two filler strings.
- 3 Make a square knot using the new working strings and existing filler strings.
- 4 Tie the knot twice. Once your piece is complete, use a large-eyed tapestry needle to reattach the tail in the back of your macramé, then cut the ends.

**ADDING A STRING WITH A DOUBLE HALF HITCH**

- 1 Take the short string (the one that needs reworking) to the back of the macramé and place the new string behind the filler string (this string is sometimes called the 'working' or 'hitch' string).
- 2 Tie a double half hitch knot (see page 20) using the new string.
- 3 Place the top end of the new string behind the macramé.
- 4 Tie the other strings using the double half hitch. Once your piece is complete, use a large-eyed tapestry needle to reattach the tail at the back of your macramé, then cut the ends.
