Mia Hansson started embroidering a full-scale Bayeux Tapestry replica, using fabrics and threads as similar as possible to those used in the original work. She is due to finish this extraordinary achievement in time for the 1000th anniversary of William the Conqueror's birth, in 2027. The Bayeux Tapestry spans almost 70 metres (77 yards) and features over 1,500 designs.







Part travelogue, part artistic meditation and part practical guide, this book invites embroiderers of all levels to discover the living heritage of Mexican embroidery and make it their own. Discover:

- distinct regional styles including Tenango, Street, Mazahua, Thought, Mixe and Purépecha embroidery, each introduced through vibrant photography, storytelling and in-depth technique;
- **experimental practices** such as Lavín embroidery (using human hair) and Romero's own abstract, texture-based compositions;
